Scott Pruitt, Administrator of Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the former Oklahoma Attorney General (AG), sues the agency 13 times and is the self-proclaimed "leading advocate against the EPA's activist agenda".

4/28/17 - Donald Trump has signed an executive order aimed at reducing restrictions on oil drilling in the Arctic and Atlantic in order to "unleash American energy". (BBC)

4/28/17 - EPA website removes information on climate change to "be updated to reflect the current administration's views". (BBC)

4/27/17 - Trumps' inner circle discusses withdrawing from Paris Agreement after Pruitt calls for exiting agreement on the 14th. (Nat'l Geo)

4/26/17 - Trump calls for review of National Monuments - declared since 1996. 40+ monuments to be reviewed. (Nat'l Geo)
